

SERVICES SCHEDULE – PEERING SERVICES

This document is a Services Schedule referred to in the New Zealand Internet Exchange Incorporated Master Services Agreement (MSA). The provisions of this Services Schedule form part of the MSA. Terms used in this Services Schedule have the meanings given in the body of the MSA.

Description of Service	Our Peering Services are intended to provide Layer 3 BGP peering between Autonomous Systems
Fees and charges	As specified by Us on the Member Portal.
Service Upgrade and Downgrade Rules	As specified by Us on the Member Portal, if any.
Reconnection Fee for suspended service (clause 19.6 of MSA)	\$500.00 plus GST
Special Conditions	<p>1.1. The provisions of this Services Schedule apply to Peering Services that You order from Us.</p> <p>1.2. In these special conditions, Peering Point means the peering point that You select and specify in Your order at the time You order Peering Services from Us.</p> <p>1.3. You must provide Your own access facilities and services to enable Your connection to the Peering Point as required and directed by Us.</p> <p>1.4. Without limiting clause 1.2, You agree that the Peering Services do not include the provision of internet access services and that You are solely responsible for Your procurement of and payment for any relevant internet access services, including any necessary bandwidth required by You.</p> <p>1.5. You agree and acknowledge that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) prior to peering with any other Member at the Peering Point, You and the other Member (or Members, if the Peering Services arrangement is on a multilateral basis) will be deemed to have confirmed that You and the other Member each consent to the Peering Services arrangement between You and them; (b) the Peering Services may not necessarily be secure; (c) the Peering Services will not be fault free or error free; (d) We and Our Suppliers do not have any responsibility for loss of data, delays, non-delivery, or mis-delivery of data; (e) We and Our Suppliers do not have any responsibility for any content accessed by You or Your customers through the Peering Services (including inaccurate, incomplete or out of date information). <p>1.6. You must not access any data or resources of other Members who You peer with unless You are authorised to do so by those Members.</p>
